

# **Barral Institute Case Study**

## **Visceral Manipulation - Leg Pain**

#### **Patient Age / Gender**

Male

#### **Patient Symptoms**

LBP and chronic disc symptoms - posterior thigh and hip pain, instability.

#### **Evaluation / Treatment**

Evaluation showed restrictions in pelvis/SI joints compressed. Significant lumbar mobility impairments and abdominal cavity organ restrictions throughout especially liver, colon, mesenteric roots of small intestines. Valves were all dysfunctional -> \*1CV (greatest), poor motilities in kidneys and pelvic floor, organs.

#### **Outcome**

After initial treatment to liver, valves and mesenteric roots he had complete reduction of leg and posterior thigh pain.
